RE: 50% Tax Credits on Charitable Donations

Dear Friends of UCP Heartland,

You remain in our thoughts during these difficult times and I ask that you keep our dedicated, essential, direct care staff in your thoughts as well. We are also grateful for your past, present and future support of our mission and the people and families we are honored to serve.

How about some good news?! UCP Heartland is eligible to grant tax credits on donations received from eligible donors. The Missouri Department of Economic Development, through the Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP), supports charitable organizations by allowing qualified persons and businesses to route their tax dollars from the state government to eligible charities. The state does this by authorizing eligible charities like UCP Heartland, to offer qualified donors a 50% tax credit on gifts over \$1,000.00.

NAP is a program of Missouri state tax credits available to businesses and individuals that contribute money to projects like UCP Heartland Employment Resources Program which help our communities.
