We envision being the provider of choice for children and adults with differing abilities and making sure all people have the opportunity to live, learn, engage, work, and reach their full potential.



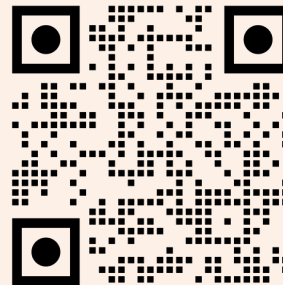

What is ABA?

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is an established scientific discipline that focuses on modifying the environment to produce meaningful behavior changes that increase the individuals independence in their school, home, and community.

What Does ABA Involve?

ABA involves implementing ongoing steps to ensure each individual achieves the best possible outcome. These steps include a comprehensive assessment, individualized treatment goals, family involvement and caregiver support, ongoing treatment evaluation, a hybrid approach, and compassionate care.
